



WELCOME TO SUMMER CERAMICS JULY 6– 29, 2010

A four week comprehensive ceramics program for young people ages 12–18.
The program is limited to 8 students.

PROGRAM GOALS

An intensive introduction to ceramic techniques, special kiln firing techniques, ceramic history and understanding of ceramic processes.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

During this four-week program, students will work on the potter's wheel and hand building, creating sculptural and vessel forms in clay. They will do glazing and two special firing techniques – Raku, a Japanese fast firing technique and high fired reduction in a large gas kiln. Additionally, students will be introduced to many types of ceramic art and learn the diverse ceramic processes used throughout history to create one of the most enduring art forms.

Classes meet 3 days a week – Tuesday–Thursday 10 AM – 1 PM

On August 22, a special exhibition of students' work will be mounted in the courtyard at Celadon Gallery located next to the Water Mill Museum on Old Mill Road in Water Mill.

PROGRAM FEES

Program fees are flexible and designed to fit the needs of each individual student. Scholarships are available and are awarded based on recommendations from the student's art teacher. Students will be notified of scholarship eligibility.
